- Maintain minimum training standards.
- Participate in callouts, weather operations and special events appropriate to the selected unit.

WHAT DO NEMA VOLUNTEERS DO?

PURPOSE:

Provide support services to Emergency Service Agencies and Disaster/Emergency situation response to Naperville and surrounding areas. NEMA is comprised of 4 different units, Field Operations, Communications, Weather and Search and Rescue.



FIELD OPERATIONS:

- Provide operational support to the Naperville Fire department, other City agencies and Mutual Aid.
- Provide scene lighting for Fire and Police operations.
- Support Mass casualty incidents.
- Provide support for local special events.

COMMUNICATIONS:

- Provide ancillary communications during limited communication periods.

WEATHER:

- Conduct "Weather Operations" during potentially damaging weather communications.

SEARCH AND RESCUE:

- Provide trained ground search and rescue support for Naperville and surrounding areas.

REQUIRED TRAINING:

Approximately 6 hours of general EMA training plus unit specific training of 6-24 hours followed by ongoing training specific to your role.
