The Naperville Riverwalk...
was a gift to the City of Naperville
from its citizens to commemorate
Naperville's 150th anniversary. It was
originally dedicated on Labor Day in
1981 in conjunction with the
Sesquicentennial Celebration.

The original section of the Riverwalk
runs from Eagle Street east to Main
Street and incorporates the Riverwalk
Amphitheater, Labyrinth, Millennium
Wall, Free Speech Pavilion, Dandelion
Fountain, Exchange Club Veterans
Plaza and Exelon Garden. In the mid
1980s the park was expanded west to
Jefferson Avenue. In the late 1990s
the Riverwalk began extending east to
Hillside Road, followed in 2003 by the
creation of Fredenhagen Park near the
Washington Street Bridge.

The linear park now boasts more than
1.75 miles of paved pathways, 3
covered bridges, a handicapped
accessible playground, a sled hill, a
visitor center, and Moser Tower built
at the turn of the millennium to house
a world-class carillon with 72 bells.

4" x 8" Commemorative Brick - \$200

*These pavers will be placed in the soldier course along the walkway somewhere between
Washington Street and Hillside Road.*

*Each brick is engraved with a 3-line message and 12 characters per line.
Punctuation and spaces are considered a character.*

8" x 8" Commemorative Brick - \$300

*These pavers will be placed somewhere surrounding the Exchange Club Memories Fountain
in Fredenhagen Park located on the east side of Washington Street.*

*Each brick is engraved with a 6-line message and 12 characters per line.
Punctuation and spaces are considered a character.*

18" x 12" Commemorative Granite Stone - \$2,500

*These granite stones are located immediately surrounding the Exchange Club Memories Fountain wall
in Fredenhagen Park located on the east side of Washington Street.*

*Each brick is engraved with a 5-line message and 14 characters per line.
Punctuation and spaces are considered a character.*
