

## Resident Notice – Actual Start of Construction Sylvan Circle and E. Porter Avenue Watermain & Roadway Improvement Project

May 2024

Dear Residents of Sylvan Circle & E. Porter Avenue,

Construction is planned to start next week Monday, 6/3 with the installation of new sanitary manholes and sanitary sewer lines. The work is planned to begin on E. Porter Avenue just east of Sylvan Circle. The excavations and equipment utilized to make the excavations will take up about half of the roadway, with potential full road closures for short periods of time throughout the working day. Be prepared for minor delays when attempting to drive past the equipment. If possible, please look to avoid the construction area by driving in the other direction around the circle. All residents will have access to their driveways throughout the duration of the project. Please alert any landscaping crews servicing your property of these impacts as their truck and trailer may require the most maneuvering to avoid the construction areas.

Our contractor has recently been out on-site surveying and setting stakes and orange construction fencing. The stakes are very important to locate where new utility structures need to be installed, so please do not remove any of these stakes for the duration of the project. The orange construction fencing is placed to limit the working area where the contractor can access. This fencing location does not mean that excavation will take place all the way up to the fencing, but does provide a good idea of where impacts to your yard may occur. If you have any private improvements in the public right-of-way that are on the roadway side of the orange fencing (e.g., sprinkler systems, landscaping you wish to preserve), please consider relocating them behind the orange fencing as protection of these items throughout construction is the responsibility of the property owner. The City's contractor will do their best to limit impacts throughout construction. However, the City is not liable for damage to any private improvements within the public right-of-way.
