Use this packet, in conjunction with the Petition for Development Approval application, to request engineering approval when consideration by the Naperville Planning and Zoning Commission and/or approval from the Naperville City Council is <u>not</u> required. The Petition for Development Approval application is available on the City's website at <u>www.naperville.il.us/developmentpetition.aspx</u>. E-Plan Review through Civic Access Portal

"E-plan review" is short-hand for electronic plan review. It is the process of reviewing development submittals in a digital format instead of on paper. All development projects submitted to the City require e-plan review through the City's <u>Civic Access Portal</u>. All plans (e.g., site plan, engineering plans, landscape plans, etc.) and application materials (e.g. parking and traffic studies, application forms, etc.) associated with these projects must be submitted to the City of Naperville electronically and must comply with the formatting and filename specifications detailed in the Naperville <u>PDF Submittal Requirements</u> and <u>Naperville Required Submittal List</u>.

ENGINEERING APPROVAL PROCESS

- Prior to submittal of a Petition for Development Approval application, please email a brief description of your project to the TED Business Group at <u>DRT@naperville.il.us</u> to determine whether or not a concept meeting is required. A Project Manager will be assigned to you at this time.
- Following your concept meeting (if required), prepare a complete Petition for Development Approval application including all materials noted in your Concept Meeting Summary. All submittals shall comply with the formatting and filename specifications detailed in the Naperville <u>PDF Submittal Requirements</u> and <u>Naperville Required Submittal List</u>.
- 3. Electronically submit the complete Petition for Development Approval application and all required plans and studies through the City's <u>Civic Access Portal</u>.
- 4. Upon receipt of the submittal, the Project Manager will review for completeness and contact you with the required fee for the project. You will be able to pay through the <u>Civic Access</u> <u>Portal</u> via credit card or e-check.
- 5. Once the submittal is determined complete and the fees have been paid, it will be forwarded to City departments (e.g. planning, utilities, engineering, etc.) for review and comment.
 - First submittals are subject to a 21 calendar day review cycle; and
 - Subsequent submittals (as applicable) are subject to a 14 calendar day review cycle.
- 6. Once all required fees are paid, the Project Manager will transmit the City's review comments to the Primary Contact identified on the Petition for Development Approval application. Comments may necessitate revisions and resubmittal.

EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF APPLICATION Please note that Petition for Development Approval applications are only valid for a period of two years from the date of application submission and that all cases will be closed by the City without further notice to the Applicant after the two-year period has expired.
