CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

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- □ In any intersection or crosswalk
- □ Within 20-feet of any intersection or cross-walk
- □ Within 15-feet of a fire hydrant
- □ Within 10-feet of a driveway
- □ Where the use of a driveway would be blocked
- □ On any sidewalk, or portion thereof
- □ Any designated as "No Parking"
- □ Within 30-feet of a traffic signal, beacon, or sign on the approaching side

An 18-foot clear roadway width is required to be maintained at 5 all times. In some cases, this may be achieved by:

- □ Limiting parking to one side of the street
- □ Staggering vehicles parked on opposite sides of the street, so that they are not parked directly across from each other

Where available parking is restricted on street, or limited on site, please consider carpooling when possible.

See Title 11, Chapter 2 of the City of Naperville Municipal Code for additional information.

These summary regulations are being provided to each applicant for a building permit where construction activities have a significant impact on the existing neighborhood and adjacent roadways. Cooperation in complying with these regulations is important, and violations will be enforced under current Ordinances. A copy of these regulations must be on the job site to provide to contractors and individuals associated with work at this site, so that compliance can be achieved and violations are minimized.
