
How to Add a Comment Using the PublicCoordinate Mapping Tool






When you click on the webpage URL, a pop-up screen appears. This screen gives information about the Road Improvement Plan project and instructions for providing feedback. When you are done reading, click the **OK** button.



Click on the **Add Comment** option on the right-hand side of the screen. You will be asked to select a comment category. You can only select one category at a time. Comments may include observations, concerns, ideas or questions.





Here is more information about the different categories:

- Potential Improvements Select this category if you have an idea for a potential road improvement.
- Intersection Conditions Select this category if you want to comment about your experience(s) with a specific intersection.
- Roadway Conditions Select this category if you want to comment about your experience(s) with specific roadways.
- Other Comment or Idea Select this category if you have a comment or idea that doesn't fit within the other three categories.


Tip: Three roadway classifications are color-coded and labeled on the map. These classifications designate the different roadway types and their function. A list of the roadway definitions can be found on the <u>Road Improvement Plan project webpage</u>.

After selecting a category, you will see a prompt that says, "Click anywhere on the map to add a comment." Navigate the map to find the specific roadway, intersection or area you want to comment about. Click on that location.




Tip: You can search for a location on the map using the Search Bar at the top.

Type your comment and select **Submit**. If you decide not to submit the comment, click **Cancel**. You should see an icon on the map where you submitted the comment. If you hover over the icon, your comment should be visible.



- If you have a general comment or an idea that is **not** tied to a specific roadway or area, you can click anywhere on the map to submit your comment.
